

CHEHALIS BASIN STRATEGY 2025-2027 BUDGET

The Washington State Legislative provided \$75 million to the Office of Chehalis Basin to support flood damage reduction and aquatic species restoration in the 2025-2027 biennium. In June 2025, the Chehalis Basin Board approved the budget below across Chehalis Basin Strategy programs and projects.
